**1. Read Genesis 2:19-25.** If married, tell your "love story." How did you meet? What was it that drew you to each other? If single, share what you know about your parents' love story or about another special couple in your life.

**2. Read 1 Corinthians 7:1-7.** Paul talks about the challenges of sexual temptation and sexual intimacy in this passage. What case for equality in marriage does Paul present in these verses?

What other difficult challenges would you say are most common in marriage? What has your faith and experience taught you about dealing with these problems?

**3. Read Ephesians 5:22-33.** What is the best representation of a marriage you ever saw in a movie or television show? The worst?

In the culture of Paul's day which addressed women only through their husbands, and by Jewish law, defined the woman as property of her husband, should Paul be considered a "chauvinist" or a "radical feminist"?

According to this passage, who would you say has the greater responsibility of selflessness in the marriage, the man or the woman?

What have you experienced or seen others experience when one of the partners in marriage is not a partner in the Christian faith? From a Biblical perspective, how would you advise someone in this situation?

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
