For discussion: When have you tried to love someone who was very unlovable? When have you experienced someone loving you even when you were very unlovable?

1. Read Exodus 17:1-7

- When have you complained to God about a situation, only to discover God had already begun to make a way through the problem?

2. Read Psalm 95

- How does weekly worship allow you to hear God’s voice?
How do you testify to God’s goodness during the week?

3. Read Romans 5:1-11

- Reflect on a time when your suffering produced endurance and ultimately produced character.

4. Read John 4:5-42

- When has Jesus met you in a place of desperate isolation or of feeling unacceptable to yourself and/or to others?

5. What elements and themes are common to the four scripture passages listed above?

Closing Prayer: Loving Lord Jesus, lead us into loving loyalty to you and your children. Lead us away from grumbling and complaining toward you and your children. While we were still sinners, you died for us. How can we judge those who have sinned against us? How do we dismiss others for their attitudes and actions when we are not even able to condone our own?
