### Winter Shelter for Homeless

John Harold’s migrant housing building could be used from November 1 to April 30. Utilities, insurance, and damages are the cost. A budget of \$30,000 has been set. The program will be run similar to Delta’s Abraham Connection. *At this time, we do not have any new information as to how quickly this will happen.*

**Kid’s Aid** bags weekend food for the school children. We bag on every other Tuesday at 3:00 p.m., rotating with the Montrose High School Honor Society.

AN OPEN INVITATION TO MEET OUR BISHOP, KAREN OLIVETO and attend a combined charge conference with our sister churches of the valley on **Wednesday, November 9 at 5:30 at Delta United Methodist church 477 Meeker Street.**

Each year, United Methodist churches celebrate their year with a Charge Conference. It is intended to look at what we have done in the past year and what we plan to do in the coming year. We have some required votes from the membership. We must vote on the pastor's compensation package, our tithe commitment to the conference, accept our membership reports, and accept our slate of leadership for 2017. Our lay servants will have their reports signed as will retired pastors. That will all happen at 6:00 pm after a worship/potluck opening at 5:30 pm when we will then separate into individual churches and conduct our official voting. *We have decided to call Domino's and order pizza delivered so we do not have to take anything for the potluck.* Our church has, traditionally, produced a charge conference booklet with all of this information along with reports from the individual committees and our budget. **Our budget will be presented for approval at our November 14 Ad Council meeting at 7:00 p.m. in Baldrige Hall.** The charge conference book will be compiled at a later date.
