Evening Meals at Shepherd's Hand

Beginning on Monday of this week, Shepherd's Hand has expanded meal service at MADA to serve evening meals to our residents from Monday through Saturday, and the Montrose United Methodist Church continues to serve supper on Sunday evenings. This means that wholesome meals are available in Montrose to homeless and other people who want them at no cost, three times per day, seven days per week.

The Shepherd's Hand evening meal service will soon be opened to "all comers!" Many volunteers have stepped forward to help with these MADA meals, but we can use more. Shepherd's Hand's Garey Martinez has somehow contrived to prepare and serve the excellent MADA evening meals for less than \$1.00 per person, and Montrose Lighthouse Ministries will compensate Shepherd's Hand for this minimal cost for the homeless we are serving.

Lighthouse is getting close to meeting the projected costs of our ministry for this winter, and the overwhelming generosity of many Montrose churches and individuals, and the City of Montrose has been amazing. Thanks so much to each of you who have had a part in serving this homeless population!
