Shepherd's Hand has expanded meal service at the MADA building to serve **evening meals** to our residents from Monday through Saturday, and the Montrose United Methodist Church continues to serve supper on Sunday evenings. This means that wholesome meals are available in Montrose to homeless and other people who want them at no cost, three times per day, seven days per week.

The Shepherd's Hand evening meal service will soon be opened to "all comers!" Many volunteers have stepped forward to help with these MADA meals, but we can use more, particularly on **Tuesdays and Wednesdays**.
